With regards to RFQ-24-1005 - Computer Equipment for KOSTT PIU, considering that for IT equipment the manufacturer authorization form (MAF) can take longer to be issued, would a distributor authorization form (DAF) also be acceptable?	As per the RFQ, Section 2, sub-section (c.) the offeror shall provide a document that proves that it is authorized by the manufacturer or authorized distributor of the manufacturer for sale or any document such as agreement with the manufacturer/ or authorized distributor. Therefore, both MAF and DAF are acceptable.	No
2	Since we are applying as a Joint Venture, do we need the same documents to be signed by authorized persons of both companies, or should we send separate every document for each company?	<p>As per the RFQ, Section 2, sub-section (a), an offer submitted by a Joint Venture, the Form of Quotation and Price and Completion schedule shall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) be signed by the authorized persons of all the partners of the JV, or (b) by a party legally authorized person to sign on behalf of the Joint Venture though the power of attorney. The authorization should be issued by all partners of the JV. <p>In addition to the requirements set in the RFQ, offers submitted by a joint venture or other association shall include a copy of the joint</p>	No

		<p>venture/Association agreement entered by all members. Alternatively, a letter of intent to execute a joint venture/Association agreement shall be signed by all members and submitted with the Offer, together with a copy of the proposed agreement.</p> <p>In the case where an Offeror is, or proposes to be, a joint venture or other association (a) all members of the joint venture or association must satisfy the requirements set out in this RFQ; (b) all members of the joint venture or association will be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the Contract; and (c) the joint venture or association will nominate a representative who will have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the joint venture or the association during the bidding process and, in the event the joint venture or association is awarded the Contract, during Contract performance.</p>	
3	Do you accept our references from our clients that we supplied them with different technology products like Arduino, Raspberry Pi etc. or the references are only accepted if they are for exactly same products that are listed in the RFQ-24-1005?	As per the RFQ, Section 2, subsection (b), the Offeror shall provide a list of at least three clients from the last five years for similar provisions/contracts. In this context, a similar provision/contract refers to a contract for the supply of laptops, workstations, external monitors, tablets, or other similar office-use informational technology equipment.
